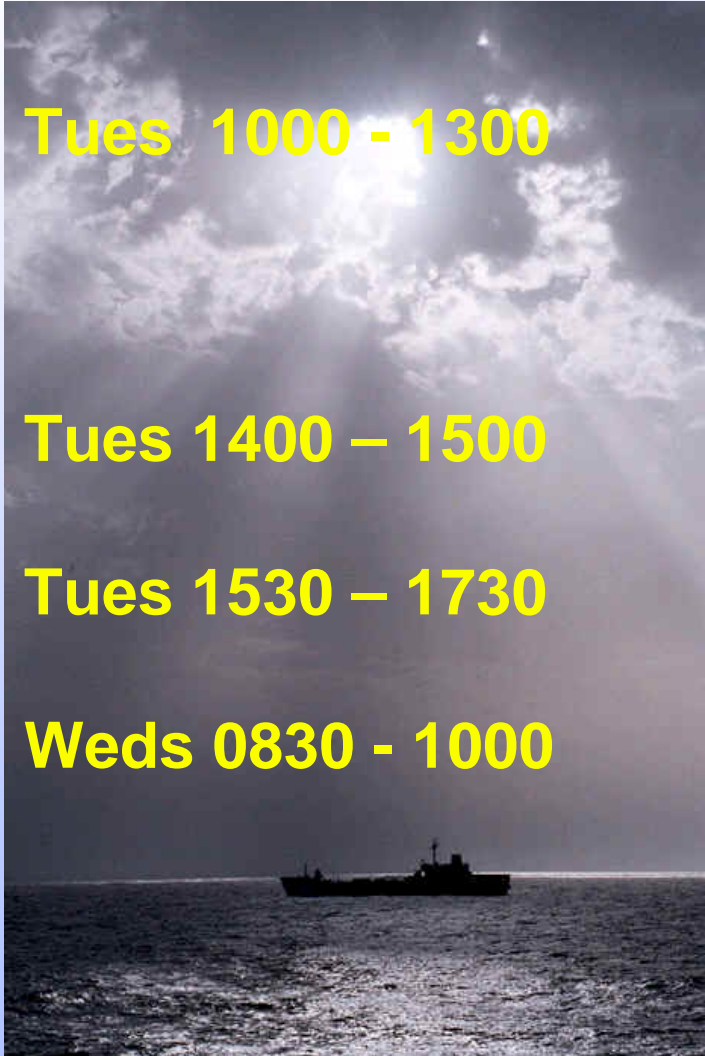

In its most comprehensive sense, those aspects of military operations which deal with: Design and development, acquisition, storage, movement, distribution, maintenance, evacuation and disposition of materiel; Transport of personnel, Acquisition or construction, maintenance, operation and disposition of facilities; Acquisition or furnishing of services; Medical and health service support.
